Subject: Regarding the forthcoming ISI Council election time schedule deviating from the decades old practices

Dear Sir,

On 07.04.2022, being the Election Officer, you have published the election schedule for ISI Council (2022-24) election, in which you have digressed from the usual practice that has been going on in ISI for the past about 20 years of holding these elections in the branches and headquarters in the month of August every alternate year. This deviation is arbitrary and whimsical, citing strange reasons like Corona waves in China, and your own one-sided opinion on the same. You may kindly remember that your adamant attitude dragged a portion of last term's election to the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court, a problem that finally required the intervention of the ISI Council Chairman for its solution at the behest of the Court.

It is to be also mentioned here for your kind attention that the proceedings of the ISI Council meeting held on March 14, 2022 that discussed the ensuing Council election procedures (Agenda A.6.5) is yet to be confirmed. Furthermore, the Council discussed the following: "The Council may also authorise the Election Officer to fix up a suitable date within which the members of the Society should pay their annual subscription up to the year 2022 in order to be eligible for participating in the ensuing election." It has never been said that the Election Officer is authorised to change this year's Election schedule deviating from the decades old practices in view of pandemic situation, leave alone something like "Corona in China". Even during the pandemic in 2020 and several restrictions being followed, ISI did not deviate from the usual practised schedule of holding the elections in August in branches and headquarter. All the workers of ISI expect that the ISI Council election (2022-24) for different posts will be held maintaining the usual schedule (i.e., during August, 2022) also. As such, we adjust our various other commitments in official and personal life, keeping this usual schedule in mind every alternate year. If there is such a sudden unexpected change, it will cause serious inconveniences to our activities and responsibilities.

Therefore, we, the following undersigned, request you to kindly reconsider the matter, so that the announced schedule for the ISI Council election (2022-24), is changed such that the usual practice in the election time schedule as in earlier years is followed.
